Founded in 2001, Engineers Without Borders USA is an international, non-profit, humanitarian organization that seeks to improve underprivileged communities through the power of engineering.

Growth

In just a little less than two decades, EWB-USA has grown to encompass almost 300 chapters in all 50 states. These chapters range from university chapters or professional chapters. Every member has an important mission to play when volunteering within the community.

Impact

Over 590,000 people have been impacted by EWB-USA in the latest project report. These people come from 23 different countries and are helped by 190 unique projects. Not all projects are visited every year, so this recent report only shows a fraction of the power of EWB-USA.

Projects

EWB-USA projects fit into 1 of the 6 following categories: water supply, sanitation, structures, civil works, energy, and agriculture. These categories are in order of greatest to lowest quantity.

Locations

EWB-USA projects are located in the following regions from most to least: Africa, Central America & Caribbean, South America, and Asian & South Pacific.

Success

76% of EWB-USA projects exhibited functionality in the most recent report. 75% of projects were proven to be self-sustainable by the community.
